## **CIRCULAR**

As advised by Vice Chancellor (cir. No. 035/VC/2020 Dt. 16<sup>th</sup> April 2020) elective courses for CBCS programs for odd semester (July 2020 – December 2020) was conducted online, CIA for all electives (GE,GL,AE,SE/SL) was completed.

At the 3<sup>rd</sup> CBCS administrative committee meeting following guidelines for assessment of elective courses (GE,GL,AE,SE/SL) were framed and the same shall be adopted for June – December 2020 session.

- 1. CIA for all the elective courses must have three assessments conducted in online mode
- 2. End semester examination for all the electives including electives specific to programs offered in June-December 2020 shall be conducted as online examination through Moodle. Examinations for students having RA grade/ NC grade in electives shall be conducted in the same manner. If such examination is not feasible for any elective, the course transactor can discuss the issue with CBCS Administrative committee.
- 3. The Heads/ Course Chairpersons/ Principals of the program offered under CBCS and CBCS office shall sensitise the students and the course transactors regarding online examinations for electives
- 4. Scheduling of examinations in concurrence with the COE office shall be provided by CBCS office.
